What is a shelter?

A shelter is a cozy and free-of-charge place to stay for those who have experienced domestic violence or threat of domestic violence. Professional staff of the shelter is available 24/7 and offers help and guidance.

You are also welcome to call us in any matters that are related to domestic violence.

Who is the shelter meant for?

The services of the shelter are meant for those who have experienced domestic violence or threat of domestic violence, if staying at home is not safe.

There is psychological, physical, sexual, economical, cultural, spiritual and honour-based violence, maltreatment and neglect.

As a client of a shelter

The shelter offers help and support in crisis situations related to domestic violence. The staff has been trained to face and work with both adults and children who have experienced domestic violence. The staff offers also guidance in legal issues and practical matters, such as arranging a new apartment.

A client or a family is offered a private room for the entire stay in the shelter. The shelter is meant for a short-time stay and the duration of the stay is always individual.

Welcome to the Shelter of Keski-Uusimaa!

Now you are safe and can calm down.

We are going to support you in your challenging situation. Our staff is bound with the duty of confidentiality, therefore, feel free to speak of your situation and experiences confidentially.

If there are no safety-related restrictions, both adults and children can feel free to continue everyday life, such as working or studying.

The stay in the shelter is free of charge and based on voluntariness.

Our shelter is open every day.
